Step into the “Welcoming House” and find yourself immersed in the culture of Alaska’s First People. Interpretive exhibits, dance performances, films and galleries give you a glimpse into the life and times of native groups from the Athabaskan and Inupiaq tribes to the Tlingit, Haida and Tsimshian Peoples. Just minutes from downtown Anchorage, the 26-acre Heritage Center is nestled on a lake and provides a walking trail through the recreated villages of five different native cultures, introducing you to their traditional crafts and lifestyle. Meeting Native Tradition Bearers, enjoying native artist and performers, touring the five historic village exhibits, demonstrations, indoor and outdoor exhibits, viewing the special film presentation, or simply delighting in the beautiful natural setting makes a visit to the Center an unforgettable experience!!

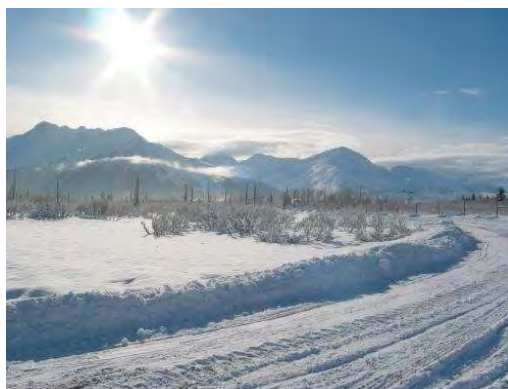
**Spring Wildlife Adventure  
(Departs From Anchorage)**

This is a great half-day tour out of Anchorage specifically designed for guaranteed, economical wildlife and scenery - this is a great value! Under \$100! Fly over foothills and spot wildlife while on your way to the Alaska Range. You will get to view Ruth Glacier, the Great Gorge and the massive south face of McKinley. This is where you'll look for climbers attempting their ascent. You will make a floatplane landing on a lake at the base of Mt. McKinley (weather permitting).

**Glacier & Wildlife Flightsee

After arrival at Lake Hood, America's largest floatplane airport, you will step aboard a floatplane for your flight to take you over the expansive Knik Glacier rimmed with spectacular hanging glaciers. Sense the motion of the ice and see how it has shaped the land, then fly over the winding Knik Glacier Gorge. Search for mountain goat, moose, bear and eagles along the way. Make a floatplane landing on a secluded lake (weather permitting – additional cost).

**Anchorage Flightseeing Safari  
(Departs From Anchorage)**

After arrival at Lake Hood, America's largest float plane airport, you will step aboard a floatplane for an Anchorage flightseeing safari and experience Anchorage and Alaska from above. Depending on the weather and mountain conditions, your pilot will choose the most scenic and interesting flightseeing option for you. One option is to soar above the Chugach Mountains, the dramatic backdrop to Anchorage, Alaska. These stunning peaks rise abruptly from the shores of Turnagain Arm and Cook Inlet, extending 300 miles across thick hemlock-spruce forests and rugged Alaska mountains. Another option is to explore Cook Inlet, Turnagain Arm or Knik Arm, spotting for Belugas or moose. Rest assured, you'll be taken for a sea plane adventure which will show you a new view.

**Tour Includes:** Transfers To/From Your Anchorage Hotel, ½ - Hour Narrated Flightseeing Tour And Logistics Staff Coordination. **There Is A 2 Person Minimum Requirement To Operate This Tour.**

**Daily Departures From Anchorage:** Departure Times Vary And Depend On The Weather Conditions.



**Alaska Horseback Riding Adventure  
(Departs From Anchorage)**

You will depart Anchorage for a relaxing 3-hour drive traveling along the breathtaking Turnagain Arm; famous for its unusual bore tide. This drive has been voted one of the Top Ten Most Scenic Drives in America by Conde Nast Magazine. Be sure to watch for eagles, Dall sheep, moose and perhaps some Beluga Whales feeding on Hooligan. You will also get a chance to see the famous Kenai River. Once in Cooper Landing, you will geared up in "outback" duster coats and hats to prepare you for an awesome horseback ride. On the trail by 11:00, you'll ride about an hour and a half then build a camp fire and have a healthy lunch including roasting hot dogs and s'mores before heading back to the ranch. Plan on about three to four hours in the saddle plus plenty of breaks to rest and take photos. A very scenic and fun wilderness ride. We're back to the ranch by 4:00 then a pleasant drive back to Anchorage.

**All Terrain Vehicle (ATV) Adventure  
(Departs From Bird Creek)**

Depart Anchorage for a 35-minute drive to Bird Creek where your adventure will begin. You will pick out your 4-wheeler and then get geared up for the ride of your life. This is not your typical trail ride. From the trailhead you will immediately enter the forest on a path made for 4-wheelers. You may cross streams, mud puddles and bridges while you are kicking up dust along the Bird Creek Trail. Your guided 4-wheeler excursion will take you through a maze of trails winding through temperate rainforest while keeping an eye out for sign of wildlife. You'll take a short hike to an overlook with spectacular views of Turnagain Arm and the surrounding mountainsides. Keep your eyes open; wildlife is prevalent along this trail. You'll have so much fun with this tour that you'll want to do it again!

**Tour Includes:** 3-Hour Guided 4-Wheeler Tour, Helmets, Rain Gear, And Logistics Staff Coordination. **There Is A 3 Person Minimum Requirement To Operate This Tour.**

**Daily Departures From Bird Creek:** Departs 10:00AM And Returns At 1:00PM.

**Note:** You Must Be 16 Years Or Older To Drive Your Own Machine. Under 16 Years Must Ride Tandem With Parent Or Guardian. Additional Charge For Tandem Machine. Transportation Is On Your Own.



**Bird Point Bike Trip  
(Departs From Girdwood)**

You will start your day by departing Anchorage for a 1-hour drive traveling along the breathtaking Turnagain Arm; famous for its unusual bore tide. This drive has been voted one of the Top Ten Most Scenic Drives in America by Conde Nast Magazine. Your bike trip will begin at the Alyeska Resort. Here you will be fitted with your bike & safety gear. From here you will bike approximately 11 miles to Bird Point along the stunning scenery of Turnagain Arm. Your guide will accompany you the entire way to Bird Point. The trail is a paved trail with a short section that is unpaved road, and is an easy bike for most levels of fitness, even beginners. There are some hills on the trail. This trail leads bikers through spruce forests, birch and alder groves and flower-filled meadows. Scenic overlooks provide views of the Chugach Mountains to the north and the Kenai Mountains across Turnagain Arm. Along the way are interpretive displays about the local area, flora and fauna. Wildlife seen along Turnagain Arm include Beluga whales, Dall sheep and occasionally, moose and black bear. Bald eagles may be spotted near the water and golden eagles further inland. Once at Bird Point, we will have refreshments and After this, our van will take you back to the resort for your evening plans.

**Tour Includes:** Guide, Bike, Helmet, Water Bottle, Hot And Cold Beverage And Logistics Staff Coordination. **There Is A Minimum Requirement Of 8 Persons To Operate This Tour.**

**Daily Departures From Girdwood:** Departs Alyeska Resort At 1:00PM And Returns Alyeska Resort 5:00PM.

**Note:** This trip will depart rain or shine so participants should be prepared for rain and dress in layers. Children are welcomed however; under 12 must be accompanied by an adult. **Helicopter Glacier Tour  
(Departs From Girdwood)**

You will start your day by departing Anchorage for a 1-hour drive traveling along the breathtaking Turnagain Arm; famous for its unusual bore tide. This drive has been voted one of the Top Ten Most Scenic Drives in America by Conde Nast Magazine. You will arrive in Girdwood and within minutes of take off from the Girdwood airport, the forest, meadows and trees merge into the realm of glaciers and pristine snowfields hanging above the old growth forest and tundra meadows. The remoteness so close to the little town of Girdwood is a treasure of geology, wildlife and premier wilderness. Traveling into Twenty Mile Valley will bring you close to the rich ecosystem of moose, bear and wolves interwoven in the scenes of river floodplains, glacial lakes, and hanging glaciers.

**Tour Includes:** 30-Minute Helicopter Flightseeing Tour, And Logistics Staff Coordination. **There Is A Minimum Requirement Of 2 Persons To Operate This Tour.**

**Daily Departures From Girdwood:** Times Vary. Dependent Upon Demand Of Tour And Weather.

**Helicopter Glacier Landing/Prince William Sound  
(Departs From Girdwood)**

Once in Girdwood your helicopter will take off and climb up the higher ridges, home to the sheep and mountain goats and across the most heavily glaciated area in North America. These broad snow regions are rimmed with some of the tallest peaks in this range, dropping in dramatic vertical, blue ice fields into the fjords of Prince William Sound. Miles of crevasses, dotted with turquoise pools, flow into Lake George, an inland lake with calving glaciers. Flying east brings you among some of the highest peaks (up to 13,000 feet) surrounded by great expanses of glacial history in the making. At the head of Colony Glacier you drop into another realm – where great hanging ice seracs perch high above the deep fjords of Prince William Sound to the south, a fantastic blend of mountain and sea. The scenery is stunning all the way back to Girdwood.

High tides flooded the area, forcing the estimated 50 to 100 residents of Portage to move. Rustic old buildings and Ghost Forests are visible signs of remains by the invading saltwater. Upon your arrival in Seward, be prepared for an unforgettable halibut fishing experience. Halibut are the largest of all the flatfishes. Some halibut exceed 400 pounds, including the 459 pound state record fish caught during 1996 in Unalaska Bay. Halibut can be found throughout most of the marine waters of Alaska as far north as Nome, along the Aleutian Chain, and throughout the waters of the southeastern Alaska panhandle. Halibut are usually on or near the bottom over mud, sand, or gravel banks. Most are caught at depths of 90 to 900 feet, but halibut have been recorded at depths up to 3,600 feet. Your experienced deep sea guides will take you to the BIG ones!
